

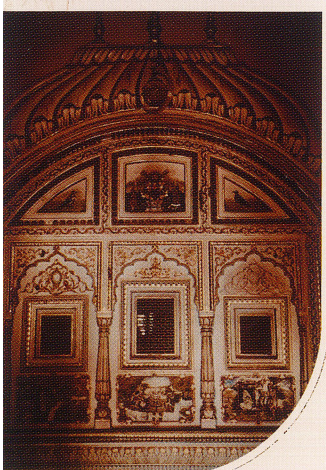

RAISING DAY CELEBRATION (16th JULY 2022)

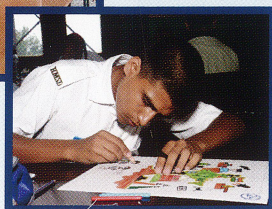
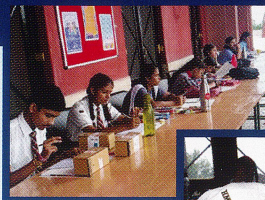

The gala dinner organised in cadets mess was thoroughly enjoyed by everyone.

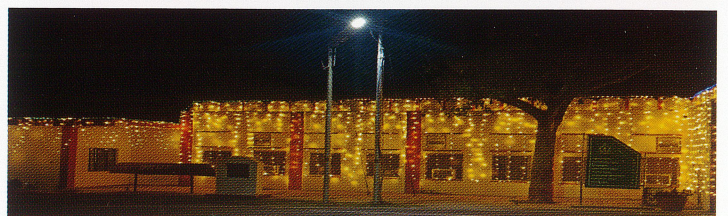
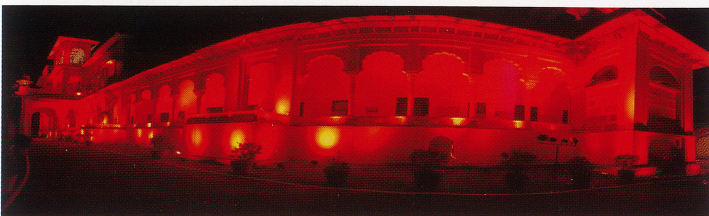
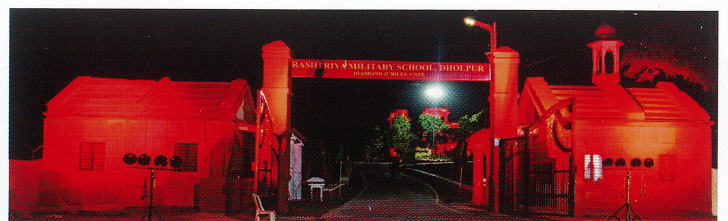
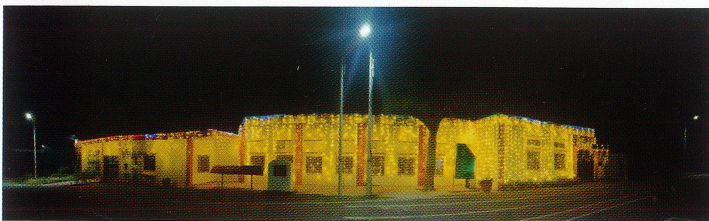


DIWALI

INTER SCHOOL BAND COMPETITION :-

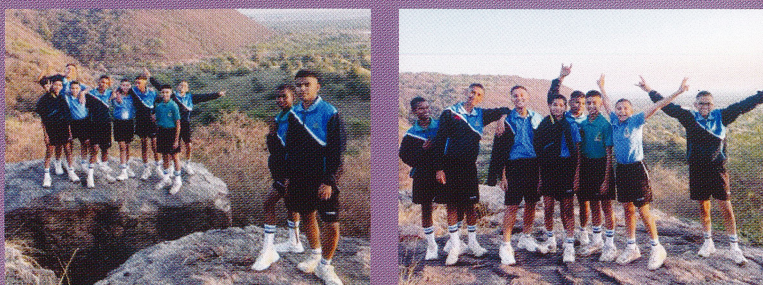

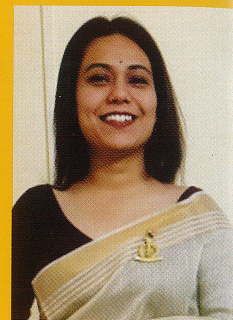




Mrs Priyanka Sharma (M/G English) undergone Diploma in Guidance and Counselling from **ICTRC, Delhi.**
