## TAKING ON GRAVITY REAL- LIFE IRON MAN LANDS IN THE PRECINCTS OF RMSD





**Richard Browning**, a British inventor and the creator of the Daedalus Flight Pack "jet suit", the founder and chief test pilot of Gravity Industries lighted his engines, bent his knees and the next minute he was ascending into the air. He hovered defying gravity, before he began to fly up and down and finally landed in the precincts of RMSD on 24<sup>th</sup> February 23 leaving the Cadets and others awestruck and agape. The astounding manoeuvres of the Mechanical Dog brought by Richard, not only captivated the interest of all but also led to the various inquisitive questions aptly answered by the 'Iron Man'.

This incredible invention was built by Browning using 3D printed parts, specialist electronics parts and five jet engines. Gravity Industries was recognized by Guinness World Record for the fastest flight in a body-controlled jet suit in November 2019 at 135 kmph.
