# PARAKH '23: EDUCATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT SURVEY



'Performance Assessment, Review and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development (PARAKH) 2023 Survey was carried out on 02 & 03 Nov 23. The sampled students were from Classes VI & IX. The teachers teaching Classes VI & IX also participated in the survey. This was done as a part of the State Education Achievement Survey. It may be recalled that the National Council for Educational Research & Training (NCERT) has launched PARAKH with an aim of removing disparities in scores of students enrolled in different state boards, in line with NEP 2020 which envisaged a standard-setting body to advise school boards regarding new assessment patterns and latest research and promote collaboration between them.

# YOGA PRANAYAM SESSION



Fully keeping with the ministry of AYUSH's effort at creating general awareness among people and community about the immense physical,

mental and spiritual benefits of Yoga, a Yoga Pranayam session was held at the School 01 Nov 23 by Mrs Padmini Jog, a Yoga practitioner well-known for conducting camps for soldiers and officers of the Armed

Forces and school students. 145 cadets attended the session in which they were taught basic 'asanas' and pranayama breathing techniques.

# **INTER-HOUSE CROSS COUNTRY RACE**

The Inter-House Cross Country Race was organized on 04 Nov 23. Held at 03 levels: Sub-juniors (Cl VI & VII), Juniors (Cl VIII & IX) and Seniors (Cl X & XI). There was a also a separate Sub-junior category for the girl cadets. The Sub-junior course consisted of 2 km, the Juniors 5 km while the Seniors had to run over a demanding 7 km course. A total of 285 cadets across the 03 levels participated in the race. On the basis of the overall points scored by the Houses,





Rajaji House bagged the 1st position and lifted the Cross Country Race trophy 2023. Tagore House was the Runner-up. Among the individual athletes, Cdt Devansh Singh, Cl VII, Shastri House won the 1st prize in the Sub-juniors category while Cdt A Homa Priya, Cl VI, Shastri House secured the 1st prize among the Girl cadets. Cdt Manav Pratap, Cl IX, Rajaji House won the 1st prize in the Juniors category while among the Seniors, Cdt Raman Yadav, Cl X, Nehru House bagged the 1st prize. Speaking after the prize distribution, the Principal reminded the cadets of the uniqueness of the Cross Country race as it is not just a test of physical endurance but an effort to

win over one's mind, a race against one's own self, a commitment to oneself and one's House. Lt Col Suresh Dhiman (Retd.) (father of the Adm Officer) who was the Guest of Honour expressed similar views and said that though it was a team event but individual effort mattered and announced a cash prize of Rs 2100/- for Cdt Raman Yadav who bagged the 1st prize in the Seniors category.
