



# PRINCIPAL'S REPORT 2022 - 2023

#### **Greetings!**

I am elated to share the Annual Report before the luminaries for the 97th Annual Day of Rashtriya Military School Chail.

At the commencement, I would express my deepest sense of gratitude to our gracious Chief Guest, Commanding Officer, Sub Area Provost Unit, Ambala Col Shyam Kumar Bhakuni, I also extend a heartfelt welcome to Mrs Saroj Bhakuni, Col GS Training, Col Adit Saxena and the galaxy of dignitaries who have made this event a memorable one. Sir, your gracious presence is a great motivation for the entire fraternity and I am sanguine that in your guidance we would set novel standards in all spheres of academic training.

It's a rare privilege bestowed on me to head the oldest Military School in Asia and being the 97th Annual Day, the responsibility has made me surge forth with zest and vigour.

Now, I take the opportunity to dwell on one of the most important segments of educational training, i.e. Academics.

#### **ACADEMICS**

It has been rightly said and I quote, "Excellence is never an accident. It is always the result of high intention, sincere effort and intelligent execution. It represents the wise choice of many alternatives. Thus, choice, not chance, determines your destiny." In the domain of academics, the cadets of the school came up with a dazzling performance in the CBSE Class X and XII Examinations. We achieved 100 percent results in the Board Classes.

4142 Cadet Shivam Raj of Nalanda House secured 97.4% to achieve the first position in Class X while 4393 Cadet Badal of Nalanda House came up with a resounding performance to achieve 95.6%.

It's a matter of gratification to inform the House that 55 cadets out of a tally of 65 secured more than 70%. The number of distinctions achieved by the cadets in various subjects speaks volumes in itself. The Tally being:

In Class XII, 4177 Cadet Shiwendu Kumar of Taxila House obtained 88% to bag the first position while 4207 Cadet Bharat Singh of Ujjain House had to contend with the second position.

In Class XII out of a tally of 33, as many as 30 cadets secured more than 60%. 23 cadets achieved a distinction in English.

I would like to make a mention of three of our cadets, namely, 4393 Cadet Badal, 4392 Cadet Harsh Kumar and 4117 Cadet Rohit Verma who scaled the summit to secure 100 marks in Class X Mathematics. Our cadets are being trained not only in terms of the coverage of the CBSE syllabus but also to develop their overall personalities so as to qualify for the National Defense Academy, it's time to reflect on the same.



Special Coaching Classes were organised for the senior cadets of the school and Subject Experts were invited to guide and prepare the cadets to face the NDA Written Exam.

I am highly delighted to inform the House that in the International Olympiads, in which over 68,000 schools competed, spread over 48 countries, our cadets put forth a brilliant performance which deserves wholehearted appreciation.

4405 Cdt Shivam Raj secured the Gold Medal in International GK Olympiad and has been awarded with a cheque of Rs 10,000/-. He also clinched a Gold Medal in the National Science Olympiad and yet another Gold Medal in the International English Olympiad.

4274 Cdt Satvik Verma came up with a promising performance and won a Gold Medal in International GK Olympiad, another Gold Medal in International Social Studies Olympiad and a Bronze Medal in National Cyber Olympiad.

4385 Cdt Kishan Kumar went on to win a Gold Medal in National Cyber Olympiad while 4407 Cdt Akshay Ashish won a Gold Medal in International Mathematics Olympiad.

Cadets of the school competed with zest in 'Manthan-2022' organised by the Rotary Club of Shimla. They came up with a promising performance in Declamation, Slogan Writing and Art Competition. 4071Cadet Rajat was bestowed with a prize for his performance in arts.
