MR SURESH DALAL, IFS

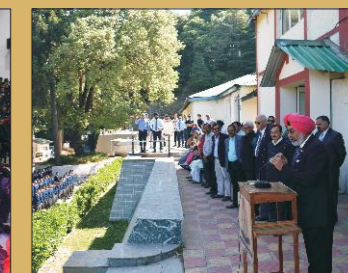
